**LACSD/AWAC Update** — The Governmental Affairs subcommittee of the Lake Arrowhead Communities Chamber of Commerce ha formally opposed this legislation. Ms. Lippert has recruited Cynthia Carley as an advocate of this legislation. It is hopeful that the Rim of the World Association of Realtors will provide a letter of support for this legislation so that the property owners in Arrowhead Woods can have a vote in the potential partnership between AWAC and LACSD.

# **Tree Cutting Issues**

- Raub Kings Crt The owners are caught up in their payments and only owe \$750.
- **Hoang/Tran Crest Cir** The appear court hear the appeal on August 8, 2022 we are awaiting the decision of the courts.

- **Hall Nadelhorn** Ms. Hall has provided an arborist report and has stated that she is willing to pay the amount calculated from the arborist (\$5,750) and not a penny more. The Bylaws of AWAC show the damage assessment of these trees as much higher than the arborist report. Ms. Upton moved [2<sup>nd</sup> Mr. Taylor] to reject this offer and proceed with the hearing as scheduled (September 8, 2022). **Motion Carried.**
- Divine Equities St Bernard -Several trees were limbed up from the ground.
  The owner has since applied for a permit. It was the consensus of the Committee
  to approve the request (after-the-fact) with a fine for failure to obtain an AWAC
  permit in the amount of \$195, which is treble the \$65 permit fee. Motion Carried
  by consensus.

- Ausman Tirol Fence The owner has provided an alternate plan which is acceptable.
- Turco West Shore Paint Trim and door have been painted this matter is closed.
- Emerson Mittry Decks Pending
- **Iglesias Walnut Hills fence –** This owner has been assessed \$15,000 for failure to meet the conditions of the hearing results. Portions of this fence are still at the property.
- **Kasbar Palisades Sheds –** A letter was sent to the owner giving her 30 days to provide an alternate plan.

- LeFevre Brentwood Shipping Container/Retaining Walls Pending
