

SACRAMENTO, CA - [Senator Rosilicie Ochoa Bogh](#) (*R-Yucaipa*) has announced that a tentative hearing date for [Senate Bill 1405](#) has been scheduled for May 1 at 1:30 p.m.

This hearing is set to take place in the [Senate Local Government Committee](#). However, the final confirmation and the committee room number will be listed in the [Senate Daily File](#) as soon as they are finalized.

The public is encouraged to attend the hearing to express their views, as it will be open to all interested parties. Information on the bill's progress can be found on the [LegInfo](#) website, where individuals can also sign up to track the bill using the "Track Bill" feature.

Senator Ochoa Bogh urges all stakeholders to actively participate in the legislative process by sending letters through the [Legislative Letters Portal](#) to the Senate Local Government Committee.
